Lindos & Local Flavours guided tour & Cooking lessons

First stop the town of Lindos is for most visitors the most impressive archaeological site on the island of Rhodes.

The view is astonishing. Over the calm waters of a wide, rocky bay, white flat-roofed houses rise up a slope from a golden, shallow, sandy beach, forming a light belt around the north side of the castle hill.

Explore the Greek nature and wonderful colours of the west coast of Rhodes and have the occasion to taste local products such as thyme honey, olive oil, souma (local spirit) and Greek tapas (meze).

Guests will have stops in several locations for pictures and flavour tastes, In apollona village the guests will visit in walking distance :

- Cooking lesson preparing (Greek salad, tzatziki, pitaroudia).
- a winery to taste Rhodian wines.
- Olive oil factory.
- Folklore museum.
- a replica of a traditional house of 100 years ago.
- Traditional bakery.
- Orthodox church.

In Lindos vehicles are not allowed. If you choose this option, the bus will leave you at the main parking and you will continue by walking.














4X4 Self driving Jeep safari

Valley of the Butterflies and Chalki island (not private)

Pick up from your hotel and before arriving to the ferry for Chalki, we will make a stop at the Valley of the Butterflies, which is a habitat with dense flora, breathtaking natural beauty, harmonious structures of bridges with the environment, paved paths, ponds, small inexhaustible waterfalls, serene atmosphere and a unique experience for the visitors. We then lead to the harbour of Kamiros Skala to the ferry. This boat trip takes you to the small paradise Chalki. Time has not touched this small fishing island, it's the ideal place for those who want to avoid crowded and cosmopolitan tourist resorts and seek for a quiet place as there are not many cars, not many shops, no bars, no disco and no water sports. The small (400m) port is very beautiful with pretty colorful houses, fishing boats, small coffee shops and few fish taverns. You will have plenty of time to walk around, to swim at the crystal turquoise water or to enjoy a delicious lunch with fresh fish.
